- 3. The old turbocharger must be returned "as removed from the engine" and not disassembled in any way and include the waste gate actuator or VNT controller (where applicable).

 - (a) Cracked/broken flanges or housings.
 - (b) External Damage to turbine and compressor housings of any kind.
